- 1. Articles can be submitted twice a year:
 - 1.1. The deadline for the social sciences volume is February 1.
 - 1.2. The deadline for the technology and biomedical sciences volume is October 1.
- 2. Articles should be sent by e-mail to: mokslas@svako.lt.
- 3. The language of publication is English.
- 4. Format requirements:
 - 4.1. Text editor Microsoft Word.
 - 4.2. Font Arial, 10 pt.
 - 4.3. Page size A4.
 - 4.4. Margins: Top and Bottom 20 mm, Left 25 mm Right 35 mm.
 - 4.5. Line spacing: single.
 - 4.6. An article length should not exceed 30.000 characters with spaces.
- 5. Articles must be structured in this order:
 - 5.1. The title of the article;
 - 5.2. The name(s) and the surname(s) of the author(s);
 - 5.3. The name of the institution;
 - 5.4. The annotation of the article (not more than 500 characters);
 - 5.5. Key words (5 words);
 - 5.6. The text of the article;
 - 5.7. Conclusions and/or recommendations:
 - 5.8. Summary (up to 2000 characters);
 - 5.9. Reference list.
- 6. **The articles should include** a presentation of the problem, research goals and objectives, methodology, an analysis of the results and conclusions (recommendations).
- 7. **Formatting of tables and figures, in-text citations and reference list**: APA style should be applied in the social sciences, Vancouver style in the biomedical sciences and ISO 690:2010 standard in the technology sciences.
