II. Šiauliai



Šiauliai is a city in the North West of Lithuania, the roots of its origin dates back to the *Battle of the Sun* in 22, Sep 1236.

Šiauliai was titled **the city of the Sun** due to its peculiar image: a bright Broadway, original and vivid cultural activities; the city is always young and full of life energy. There are about 15 000 people studying at Higher Schools in Šiauliai; about 2 000 of them study at Šiauliai State University of Applied Sciences.

Guests of the County as well as its inhabitants have a possibility to get acquainted with significant cultural monuments and famous places. There are museums, estates, mounds, more than 20 homesteads, natural monuments and parks in the region.

V. Application Procedure

Incoming Erasmus+ students have to fill in the documents provided by Šiaulių valstybinė kolegija / HEI or they can be found on the website:

- Copy of Identification (ID) card / Passport.

After submitting necessary documents, International Relations Coordinator will provide Acceptance letters within 3 weeks of submission of documents .

For non-EU citizens Meditorial letters for visa will be issued within 2 weeks after receipt of Copy of Passport.

Nomination deadlines:

- **For spring semester:** 15th November

Application deadlines:

- **Autumn semester:** 15th of June
- **Spring semester:** 20st of December

VI. Attendance and Marks / Grading system

Erasmus+ studies:

- ⇒ During 4 weeks after arrival to University – students have to make all changes to their original Learning Agreements. Students have to arrange their Changes to LA with the departments at Sending and Receiving institutions.
- ⇒ The schedules of lectures are given out by certain department.
- ⇒ The marks consist of: Attendance, Work during classes, Assignments and Exam.
- ⇒ The attendance will be guided by each teacher.
- ⇒ During Exam session teachers will fill in the Transcript of Records. Final versions of TOR will be issued by the end of the semester.
- ⇒ Each student will receive the Certificate stating one's period of stay.

Erasmus+ internship:

- ⇒ During 4 weeks after arrival to the University – students have to make all Changes to original Learning agreement for Traineeship (if there is a need to change).
- ⇒ The mark consists of Attendance, Work during internship and extra assignments.
- ⇒ Certificate and Transcript of records will be issued by the end of the internship.

VII. Arrival to Šiauliai city

The nearest airports to Šiauliai:

Riga International Airport (Latvia)

Distance from Riga (Capital city of Latvia) to Šiauliai is 128 km. Information on bus lines and schedules from Riga Airport to Šiauliai city is available on:

There is no train connection with Šiauliai city from Riga.

Vilnius International Airport (<https://www.vilnius-airport.lt/en/>)

Distance from Vilnius (Capital city of Lithuania) to Šiauliai is 214 km.

There is a direct train route from **Vilnius Airport to Vilnius Railway Station**. Ticket price is 0,80 Eur (3rd class).

How to get from Vilnius Railway Station to Šiauliai City?

NOTE! Please pay attention, that there are no night routes (train or bus) !!!

In case of late arrival to Vilnius — please take care of the accommodation in the city. And safely board the chosen transportation the next day.

The best way to get to the dormitory by bus is to take **Bus No. 12** (Route: Dainų žiedo st. – Kuršėnkelio žiedo st.) and get off the bus in bus stop called “Darbininkų st.”

Dormitory rules

1. Peace and rest time from 11 p. m. till 7 a. m.
2. Guest visitors can visit till 11 p. m.
3. The student who has a visitor is responsible for keeping up with the rules.
4. The dormitory's residents carry out the dorm manager's requirements.
5. The residents maintain the order and cleanliness of the rooms and other premises.
6. The resident saves electricity and water. Turns the lights off before going out of the room, turns off the water before going out of the shower or kitchen.
7. To maintain the cleanliness in the kitchen according to given schedule.
8. It's strictly forbidden for dorm residents to:
 - 8.1. to move to another room without manager's permission;
 - 8.2. to selflessly carry out dormitory's inventory to other rooms;
 - 8.3. to return to dormitory intoxicated;
 - 8.4. use alcoholic drinks, drugs, gamble in the dormitory premises, play loud music after 11 p. m.
 - 8.5. make noise, litter, smoke in rooms, hallways, kitchens, lavatories, toilets, stairweels;
 - 8.6. keep easily flammable liquids, explosives, use electric heating devices in the room;
 - 8.7. provide accommodation for unauthorized persons;
 - 8.8. pour garbage through the window, throw in the toilet and other common areas
 - 8.9. use kitchen lavatories or toilets if the sewerage is out of order. The resident have to let dormitory's manager, watcher or other Universities staff into their room at any time of the day.

XV. Places to visit

1. Šiauliai Cathedral of the Apostles St. Peter and St. Paul

Address: Aušros str. 3

Renaissance architectural monument St. Peter and Paul's Cathedral (till 1997, the church) is the most striking landmark of the city.

The visitor is kind of directed to the city centre.

The cathedral dominates both due to its impressive height (the apex of the tower reaches 70 m) and the convenient and well-chosen location. This is the merit of builders of the first wooden church of Šiauliai.



2. Iron Fox and Talkša lake

Address: The southern shore of Lake Talkša, Šiauliai

The shore of Lake Talkša is simply created for active recreation; here you will always find what to do: jogging and cycling trails, Wakeboarding Park FoxSpot, the Equestrian Centre operating in the Centre of Young Naturalists.

The Iron Fox, designed by V. Purnas, has stood near Lake Talkša since 2009. It is recorded in Lithuania's Book of Records that it is the largest animal sculpture: its weight is nearly 7 tons, length is about 15 meters and height is 6,6 meters.



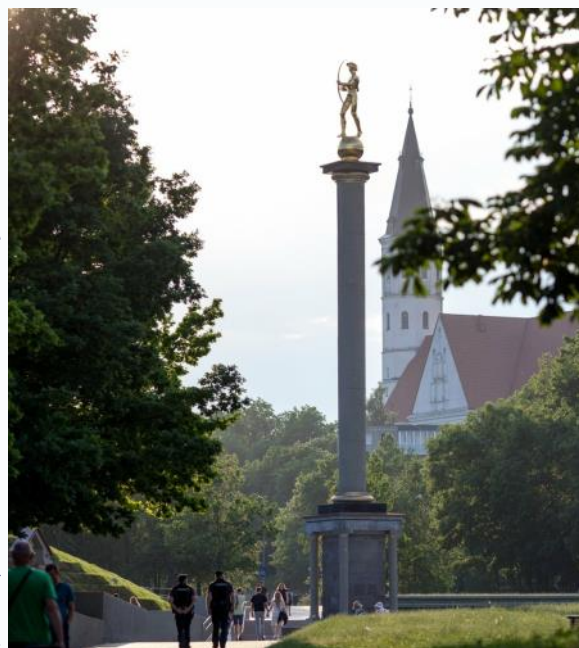
3. Sundial Square and Golden boy

Address: Ežero St. - St. Šalkauskio St.

The main idea of the square is to give a sense to *the three most important symbols* of Šiauliai city: *the Sun*, remembering the Battle of the Sun, which took place in Šiauliai land, *the archer* (lit.- Šaulys), associated with the origin of the name of the city, and *time* that has passed since the day when the name of the city was mentioned for the first time.

On a sunny day, this obelisk turns into the gnomon: casting the shadow of the Sun, moving around the dial face with infused metal numbers (12, 3 and 6), it shows local time of the geographical latitude. It is the highest sundial in Lithuania.

The sculpture "The Archer", symbolising the city of Šiauliai, often by Šiauliai residents referred to as the golden boy or he small archer. The four-meter-high sculpture was covered with 1900 *gold foil sheets*, thickness of which is just a few microns.



4. Šiauliai Boulevard

Address: Vilniaus str.

In 1975, we were brave: the third in Europe (after Rotterdam in 1972 and Erfurt in 1973) and the first in Lithuania who turned the central part of Vilniaus Street (1,28 km from Žemaitės Street to Draugystės Avenue), which belonged to vehicles, into a boulevard. Šiauliai Vilniaus Street, like Tilžės Street, built in the 18th century, is a historical road leading from the east to the west; while Tilžės Street, from the south to the north.



5. Hill of Crosses

Address: Piliakalnio str. 7, Domantų village

In the Middle Ages, there stood a wooden castle on this hill, called Kula in the chronicles. It was destroyed by the Livonian army in 1348. For many years, the hill called Pilis, Maldavimai, Jurgaičiai, Domantai Mound, stood bare. Local people told that the first crosses had been built in the middle of the 19th century, praying God for grace and health, because people considered this hill to be a holy place. Others claimed that it was started to build crosses to remember those who were killed in the uprisings of 1831 and 1863 against the Tsarist Russia. After suppressing the uprising, the occupation authorities prohibited construction of crosses and destroyed the already built ones. Now It has about 100 000 crosses.



XVI. Museums

1. Rūta Chocolate museum

Address: Tilžės str. 133, Šiauliai

Take a look at nearly four millennia-long history of chocolate. Learn how it was made by the Maya and Aztec peoples, and how chocolate and its consuming traditions have changed since then. Find out about the first chocolate and candy factories in Lithuania and take a closer look at RŪTA, the oldest operating candy factory in the country.



2. Bicycle museum

Address: Vilniaus Street 139, Šiauliai

The only devoted to the history of bicycles museum in Lithuania welcomes the visitors with interactive exposition. In the museum, which was established 4 decades ago, the traditional expositions match with the latest technologies. Each visitor here becomes an active participant, capable to familiarize with the history of bicycle and try out the entertainment. Visitors can order guided in Lithuanian, Russian, English languages.



3. Žaliūkių Village Miller's Farmstead

Address: Architektų St. 73, Šiauliai

A space for ethnoculture, customs and traditions, activities and merry-making is surrounded by modern city. There was recreated miller's farmhouse and restored the only survived in Šiauliai construction of Lithuanian traditional wooden architecture from the 2nd part of the 19th c. – Žaliūkių Windmill. All-year-round the everyday life of Miller's family – grain grinding, bread baking – is going on; sometimes it is spiced by Lithuanian traditional calendar celebrations.



4. Chaimas Frenkelis Villa

Address: Vilniaus Street 74, Šiauliai

The restored Chaimas Frenkelis Villa with a park, and a fountain located in it, is a very exclusive site in Šiauliai city. The Villa is unique, one of only a few in Lithuania constructed in early 20th century buildings in the Art Nouveau (Modern, Secession, Jugend) architectural style. Elements of different styles interweave in decoration of this State protected cultural monument's facades, authentic interior fascinates the visitors with ornate wooden decorations, stucco works, and imposing fragments of frescos.



5. Photography Museum

Address: Vilniaus Street 140, Šiauliai

Photography Museum is a specialized museum of photography art, one and only in Lithuania. It is an important multifunctional center, which preserves and represents significant collection of 150 000 objects, an important part of Lithuanian visual heritage: photographs, technology and equipment of photography, collection of prints and documents, other objects. In 2014th, modernized museum started to organize photography exhibitions of contemporary and historical Lithuania, as well as foreign exhibitions.



6. Museum of Cats

Address: Žuvinių Street 18, Šiauliai

For more than 20 years, the Cats Museum has been putting Šiauliai city on the map around the world. The museum was founded in 1990 by the naturalist Vanda Kavaliauskienė (1923-2011). Her abundant collection of the most various cats, which even could not be accommodated at home any longer, was brought here. Now, the exposition collected by Mrs Vanda is a unique museum of this kind in all the Baltic states. Here one can see cat statues, pictures, postcards, postage stamps, dishes, toys, drawings, books, even read poems about cats.
